Nonresidential Building Permit Fee Schedule

In addition to the fees, deposits and bonds noted in Section 1424.12(a) and elsewhere in these Codified Ordinances, the following fees shall be charged prior to commencement of any work involving nonresidential properties in the City of Solon, plus an additional three percent (3%) of the total fees collected for plan review and inspections, which will be charged for the assessment to be paid to the Ohio Board of Building Standards. (Nonresidential – all Commercial & 4(+) Family Residential buildings)

Residential Building Permit Fee Schedule

In addition to the fees, deposits and bonds noted in Section 1424.12 (a) and elsewhere in these Codified Ordinances, the following permit fees shall be charged prior to the commencement of any work involving residential construction, including additions and accessory structures greater than 168 square feet, plus an additional one percent (1%) of the total fees collected for plan review and inspections, which will be charged for the assessment to be paid to the Ohio Board of Building Standards.

Contractor's registration fee is seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) annually, plus ten dollars (\$10.00) per each additional trade as outlined in Chapter 1430, "Registration of Contractors." In addition, the provisions of Chapter 836, "Landscape Contractors," Chapter 860, "Sewer Installers," Chapter 850, "Privy Vault Cleaners and Garbage Collectors" and Chapter 1072, "Snow Removal Service," shall be strictly adhered to where applicable.

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Deposits

In addition to the fees noted in this Section 1424.12 and elsewhere in the Codified Ordinances, the provisions of Sections 1048.06 and 1426.01, 1426.02 and 1426.03 relative to deposits shall be strictly adhered to.

Deposits shall also be required for incomplete work in accordance with the provisions of section 1424.08 (temporary occupancy certificates).

Road opening/right-of-way deposits (Reference 1042.03):

All amounts except \$100.00 are refundable once work and restoration are complete. The requirements of Chapter 1020 shall be strictly adhered to.

Bonds

Bonds are required for the registration of contractors under Sections 860.04, "Sewer Installers," 1072.02(d), "Snow Removal Services" and Chapter 1430, "Registration of Contractors" and for applicable work under Sections 868.01, "Topsoil Removal," 1426.06, "Security for Re-Seeding," 1468.01, "Housing Moving," and 1283.05, "Wireless Communication Antennas and Towers."
