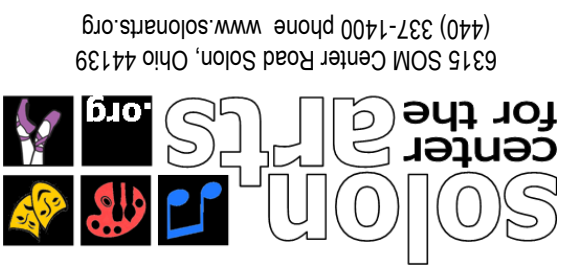

To be considered for exhibition, please read the following information thoroughly. Submissions will be accepted year-round. Based upon the panels recommendations, a representative from SCA will contact you and arrange a time to view your work in person and/or request images.

What SCA is looking for:

- Artists with professional artwork
- Art that shows a broad range of skills and talent
- Art that is properly displayed and exhibition ready (i.e. framed, matted, dry and finished)
- Art that is family-friendly

What SCA is not looking for:

- Art that is offensive and/or inappropriate for viewers of all ages (i.e. images that contain adult content, violence, nudity and/or illegal behavior will not be accepted)
- Art that is unfinished, displayed poorly and/or does not represent professional standards

SCA will provide:

- A listing of the exhibition in the upcoming SCA catalogue (time permitting - distribution 10,500+ households), a listing of the exhibition on Facebook and any additional marketing such as posters and/or postcards.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

The review committee at SCA reserves the right to decline an application if any of the following criteria is not met and/or the content is deemed inappropriate.

- A completed and signed *Call for Artists* Application.
- A hard copy resume and artist's statement.
- Artists must submit a link to artist website or a CD of at least ten and a maximum of 30 images of their artwork.
- Artwork must be entrant's own work.
- All images must be of work that is currently in the artist's possession. If a piece is not able to be displayed, do not submit it as an example.
- Entry Forms and photos will NOT be returned. Please make a copy for your records.

THE SPACES

SCA maintains professional installation and presentation standards, however, the locations at Solon City Hall and SCA often serve as multipurpose spaces. Due to the nature of how each space is used, there may be some exhibition limitations.

EVALUATION

A panel of visual arts professionals will review proposals from artists quarterly. Recommendations from the blind judging will narrow down the final selection of exhibits for the season. *Please note that two artists may be scheduled to exhibit concurrently.*

ONCE ACCEPTED

SCA will contact you by phone or email and will provide you with a list of available exhibition dates and additional requirements. At that time, the artist and SCA will review the exhibition location, opening reception and any additional needs.

ARTIST'S RESPONSIBILITIES

Artists are responsible for any additional expenses including but not limited to:

- special installation needs
- additional furniture or lighting materials
- opening reception expenses
- shipping of artwork and any additional mailings
- delivery and pick up of their artwork

Artists must make arrangements for the delivery and pick up of their artwork as well as ensuring it ***is ready to be displayed upon arrival.***

Each artist is responsible for insuring their work. Solon Center for the Arts cannot be held responsible for any damage or loss that may occur while artwork is on display.

SALE OF ARTWORK

The sale of exhibited work is encouraged but not required. Solon Center for the Arts shall retain 30% commission. The Artist shall be paid 70% of the retail price for each piece sold by Solon Center for the Arts.
